INCOMING ERASMUS STUDENTS

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Students are to complete and send the following forms:

- i. University of Malta Registration Form
- ii. Erasmus Students Registration Form
- iii. Erasmus Enrolment Form
- iv. IHC Health Questionnaire
This is to be completed in two parts, both of which are to be signed and stamped by a Medical doctor.
- v. Garden View Accommodation Form
Apartment availability and applicable prices are usually provided by the end of September
- vi. Registration of Radiography Study Units Form
- vii. Important Information Form (*once all travel details are known*)
- viii. Embassy Registration Form

In addition to these forms, students are also required to submit: -

- a) 6 (six) passport size photographs
- b) A photocopy of your passport or identity card
- c) A Copy of your European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) and a copy of your Travel Insurance*

*** Students are requested to take out a Travel Insurance that covers items not covered by the EHIC, such as: personal belongings, health services not covered by the EHIC, evacuation and repatriation.**

- d) For all students (except British native speakers) a declaration from the Socrates/Erasmus coordinator stating that the nominated student has a good command of the English language, is able to write assignments in English and is able to follow lectures in English with profit.[†]

† Language of Instruction

*The Language of instruction at the University of Malta is in English, and **students are expected to be fluent in the English language.** It is the student's and the home coordinator's responsibility to ensure that students are fluent in the English Language. No particular concessions are allowed to students whose level of English is lower than expected.*

Students' acceptance is conditional to the acceptance from the European Unit and is also conditional to the receipt of all the required forms/documents in original format.
